



## Alabama CNA Certification Checklist

- ☐ Become CPR-certified before starting clinical training (Basic Life Support certification recommended)
- ☐ Have current immunizations, TB skin test and Hepatitis B series before beginning training

### Complete training through one of the following:

- ☐ A CNA program approved by the Alabama Department of Health with at least 75 hours of training, including 16 hours of clinical training and 16 hours of labs
- ☐ Equivalent training through higher education, such as an LPN or RN program approved by the Alabama Board of Nursing
- ☐ A state-approved training program at a long-term care facility

### Pass one of the following:

- ☐ Nurse Aide Competency Exam administered by Prometric
- ☐ NNAAP exam administered by Credentia

*Must pass the exam within 3 attempts and 24 months of the completion date of the nurse aide training program or retraining required before testing again.*
