



Oklahoma CNA Certification Checklist

- ☐ Complete a state-approved nurse aide training and competency program of at least 75 hours that uses a performance record/skills performance checklist
- ☐ Submit the Original Training Verification Form signed by the training program supervisor
- ☐ Complete a State-required criminal background check if the training and competency evaluation program was employer-based
- ☐ Pass both the written/oral exam provided in English and the skills exam provided at an Oklahoma State Department of Health-approved testing site and administered and evaluated by Prometric
- ☐ Be placed on the Oklahoma Nurse Aide Registry
- ☐ Optional: Pursue additional written certification exams for nurse aides through the Health Certification Project to be recognized as a specific type of CNA by Oklahoma, including:
 - Long Term Care
 - Home Health
 - Developmentally Disabled Care
 - Adult Day Care
 - Residential Care
