



Rhode Island CNA Certification Checklist

- ☐ Reach at least 16 years of age
- ☐ Complete a Rhode Island Nursing Assistant Training Program licensed by the State of Rhode Island Department of Health with at least 80 hours of classroom education and 40 hours of clinical training
- ☐ Apply for a nursing assistant license using the Application for License as a Nursing Assistant by Examination
- ☐ Submit Original Background Check with stamp and seal from the Rhode Island Attorney General's Office
- ☐ Submit a copy of driver's license or state-issued photo ID
- ☐ Submit the online application through Credentia to sit for NNAAP Examinations, including written and skills testing
- ☐ Pass both parts of the CNA competency examinations

Must pass the exam within 1 year of beginning the CNA training program.
